

**Dianas of the Chase Race**  
**Ingarsby Old Hall – 10<sup>th</sup> December 2017**  
**Information Sheet**

**Spectators** – Spectators are very welcome, there is an entry charge of £5 per car. Please park in signed areas. Dogs are welcome but please note you are on grazing land so all dogs must be kept on a lead and cleaned up after at all times. Please be aware there are no barriers on the course. The field may get strung out – please take extreme caution that you do not cross competitors' paths until the commentator gives the all clear that the last rider is home and please be vigilant for loose horses.

**Refreshments** – There will be a food van and bar situated next to the courtyard, please bring cash as neither will take card payments.

**Location** – Ingarsby Old Hall, Ingarsby, Leicestershire LE7 9JL ***Competitors please note there is a low bridge (12'3") when approaching the Hall from Ingarsby Road (Keyham/Hungarton side) All large vehicles are advised to use Houghton on the Hill on the A47 as their sat-nav destination (the postcode of the Rose & Crown pub which is in Houghton on the Hill and very close to the turn for Ingarsby is LE7 9HJ) . Once in Houghton on the Hill take the turn opposite the JET garage and this road will take you straight to the Hall.***

**Stewards & Helpers** – We cannot run this event without the help of stewards and helpers. We always need as many as possible. If you would like to offer your services as a steward or stewards helper, please attend the stewards briefing which will be in the main courtyard at Ingarsby Old Hall at 10am sharp on the day of the race.

9am – course available to be walked & secretary available for declarations, collecting numbers & handing in disclaimers

10am – Stewards & Helpers briefing – main courtyard

10.45 – Declarations close

11.30 – Parade of mounted riders in the main courtyard

12 noon – Dianas of The Chase Race

1pm – Dismounted prize giving in the main courtyard

1.30pm – Invitational champagne reception in the main house (you will be required to show your invitation to gain entry) but the bar in the main courtyard will remain open.

## **Competitors –**

All competitors must have declared to the secretary and handed in their signed disclaimer before 10.45am on the morning of the race. All competitors and their horses should be turned out as for hunting (ratcatcher is fine) – no cross country silks or colours please. Competitors may wear whatever headgear they wish for the parade, photos & prizegiving, but all competitors are to wear a correctly fastened skull cap with a plain cover of either black, navy, brown or other suitable subdued colour with no coloured pom-poms, decoration etc for the race. Hat cameras may be worn but this entirely at the rider's risk. Body protectors and/or air jackets are not compulsory but the wearing of a body protector of some description is strongly recommended. If an eventing medical armband is worn, please wear it underneath your arm number.

### **COMPETITORS, PLEASE NOTE:**

- 1) The course has changed from previous years, so all competitors should walk the course carefully.**
